The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has invoked the writ jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking appropriate writ in the nature of mandamus for issuance of directions to the respondent to consider the representation dated 09.05.2021 (Annexure P1) of the petitioner regarding restoration of pension and in alternative seeking a direction in the nature of certiorari for quashing letter dated 11.06.2021 (Annexure P4) whereby representation of the petitioner was rejected.

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with

direction to the respondent to consider the representations dated 09.05.2021, 29.05.2021 and 09.06.2021 (Annexure P1 to P3) and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
