[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating action against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 10.12.2021 in CWP-25093-2021.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 dated 10.12.2021 reveals that CWP-25093-2021 was disposed of by directing the respondent to consider and decide legal notice dated 02.12.2021 in accordance with law by passing a speaking order within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] Learned AAG, Punjab has produced copy of order dated 14.03.2022 deciding the representation and approving the appointment of the petitioner as Clerk instead of Peon. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in view of order dated 14.03.2022, the petitioner does not press the instant petition. Learned Statecounsel also contends that pursuant to claim of the petitioner as contained in legal notice dated 02.12.2021 having

instead of Peon, order dated 10.12.2021 in CWP-25093-2021 has been complied with, therefore, no action is called for against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971

[4] I have considered the submissions of learned counsel.

[5] Admittedly, order dated 14.03.2022 has been passed in compliance of order dated 10.12.2021 in CWP-25093-2021 deciding the claim made by the petitioner in legal notice dated 02.12.2021 and in pursuance thereof, the petitioner has been issued appointment letter dated 14.03.2022 as a Clerk instead of Peon.

[6] Accordingly, in the light of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the contempt petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
