Through this petition filed under Section 438 read with Section 482 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in Complaint No.07/2020 dated 04.11.2016, under Sections 148, 149, 211, 218, 220, 323, 342 and 506 IPC and Section 3(i), (ii), (iii), (v), (ix) and (xv) of the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, (in short, 'the 1989 Act') filed in the Court of the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Panipat, (however the petitioner summoned under Sections 323 and 506 IPC and 3 (x) of the 1989 Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the order dated 21.02.2022 passed by this Court, the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court and has been released on interim bail, vide order dated 04.03.2022 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Panipat.
