MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU, J.

Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for issuance of a writ in the nature of *certiorari* for quashing of the impugned order dated 18.10.2021 (P-10) passed by respondent No.3-District Education Officer (Secondary Education), Ludhiana, whereby petitioner has been dismissed from service w.e.f. 29.03.2004.

At the outset, learned Counsel on instructions from the petitioner submits that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case the statutory appeal pending before the authorities is considered and decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the aforesaid limited extent.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Maloo Chahal, DAG Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioner.

Learned State counsel, after obtaining instructions from the quarter concerned, submits that the appeal shall be decided within a period of eight weeks.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.2- Director Public Instructions (Secondary Education), Punjab, to consider and decide the appeal filed by the petitioner in accordance with law by passing speaking order on or before 30.04.2022.
