Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in Complaint Case No.COMI/151/2021 titled as Balvir Singh @ Kala Vs. Raj Kumar, under Sections 379, 447, 427 IPC read with Section 3 & 4 of SC&ST Act, but summoned under Sections 451, 380, 323 IPC read with Section 3 of SC&ST Act.

Vide order dated 21.02.2022, the petitioner was granted interim bail by this Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the

aforesaid order, the petitioner has surrendered before the trial Court and is facing the trial.
