This petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is filed seeking anticipatory bail in case of FIR No.40 dated 18.9.2021, under Section 67-B of Information Technology Act, 2000, registered at Police Station State Cyber Crime, SAS Nagar, Mohali.

From the pleadings it is apparent that the petitioner was served notice under Section 41-A(1) Cr.P.C. for appearance. Because of appearing before the Investigating Officer, he moved this petition for anticipatory bail.
