This is a criminal writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to respondents no.1 to 4 not to harass the petitioners and not to interfere in the life of the petitioners and to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners who are living in live-in-relationship.

Petitioner no.1 is stated to be born on 22.05.2004 and petitioner no.2 is stated to be born on 05.01.1995 as per aadhar cards Annexures P-1 and P-2 respectively and thus, at present they are both major.

Learned State counsel, on instructions of ASI Sukhminder Singh, has submitted that the said petitioners are staying far away from Fazilka and at present the petitioners have telephonically informed that there is no apprehension of threat to their life and liberty and thus, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

No one has appeared on behalf of the petitioners.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. In case petitioners have any threat perception to their life and liberty, they can move an application before respondent no.2 and respondent no.2 would consider the same and take action, in accordance with law.
