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HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

This is petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in FIR No. 277 dated 28.11.2020 registered under Sections 147, 148, 149, 302 IPC at Police Station Sadar PGIMS, Rohtak.

FIR was registered on the information given by Krishan who stated that on 27.11.2020 he had gone to attend marriage function. At about 9.00 pm, 2 boys namely Ashish alias Kali and Dharam Singh came and started using abusive language against his sister in law. His son Ravinder asked them not to use such language. Then they went away threatening his son that they will see him in future. At about 9.30 pm, Dharam Singh, Ashish alias Kali alongwith 5-7 other persons came there. They started beating Ravinder. Ravinder started bleeding profusely from his nose and mouth. He became unconscious. He was taken taken to PGIMS Rohtak where he died.

Learned counsel for petitioner has contended that petitioner has not been named in FIR. It is only in the supplementary statement of complainant wherein name of petitioner and other co accused surfaced. She has referred to post mortem report. She stated that as per post mortem report, deceased suffered 3 injuries namely contusion, a lacerated wound and a penetrated wound which led to death of Ravinder. As per post mortem report, cause of death was injury given with a sharp edged weapon (sua) which is attributed to co accused Gaurav. The

petitioner is stated to be in custody since 2.12.2020. The petitioner has clean antecedents. There is no criminal case registered against him. The other co accused namely Munish, Sunil alias Kaira, Sombir alias Som and Sahil have been granted regular bail by trial Court vide orders Annexure A-1 to Annexure A-3.

In view thereof, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind bars. Hence, petition is allowed. Petitioner Rajmal alias Raju is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
