The hearing of the case is being held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

This is petitioner's third attempt to get bail pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR No.289, dated 21.11.2019, registered under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, 1985, at Police Station Kalanwali, District Sirsa, Haryana.

As per the case of the prosecution, the petitioner along with other accused was apprehended with 2400 NPx Tramadol Hydrochloride Tablets 100 Mg.

On instructions, the learned counsel representing the State submits that there is a similar case pending against the petitioner for the alleged recovery of 600 Tramadol Tablets.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, no ground to grant concession of bail is made out.

Dismissed.

However, the learned trial Court is requested to make a sincere endeavour for expeditious conclusion of the trial.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
