This revision petition has been filed under Article 227 Constitution of India for setting aside the order dated 31.01.2020 passed by the learned Presiding Officer, Debt Recovery Tribunal-II, Chandigarh in SA No.26 of 2020 titled as “*Sudha Joshi Vs. HDFC Bank Ltd. and others*”, whereby it has permitted the respondent bank to take physical possession of the residential house of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the impugned order dated 31.01.2020 arises from proceedings in SA No.26 of 2020 and the same has finally been decided against the petitioner and the final decision passed in SA is already under Challenge before the Debt Recovery Appellate Tribunal.
