The present application has been filed for the grant of interim bail to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the new born daughter of the petitioner is critically ill and there is no one else at the house to take care of her hence, the petitioner may be granted the concession of interim bail so as to take care of his new born child, who is critically ill.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Satnam Singh submits that they have verified the fact and the female child was born on 20.02.2022 and the child is in critical condition as of now and there is no one else at the house to take care of the wife of the petitioner as well as his new born child.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone

through the record with their able assistance.

Keeping in view the facts stated hereinbefore, prima-facie, the presence of the petitioner is necessary to arrange the medical facility, if any, to ensure that the critically ill new born daughter of the petitioner receive all required medical attention.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has undertaken before this Court that in case the petitioner's prayer for the grant of interim bail is accepted, the petitioner will not misconduct or violate any provisions of law.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances stated hereinbefore, the application is allowed and the petitioner is granted the concession of interim bail starting from tomorrow i.e. 25.02.2022 till 28.03.2022 subject to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned. Petitioner is also directed to surrender on 28.03.2022 by 05:00 P.M. before the jail authorities and compliance be informed to this Court as well.

CRM No. M-7594 of 2022

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as the interim bail has been granted to the petitioner, the petitioner does not wish to press this petition for the grant of regular bail, at this stage and the same may be disposed of as such.

Ordered accordingly.
