Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.429 dated 20.05.2019 for offences punishable under Sections 406, 420 IPC and 120-B (added later on) registered at Police Station City, Panipat.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 16.03.2022 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sandeep submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 16.03.2022 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 16.03.2022 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
