The petitioners seek grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.571 dated 17.09.2021 registered under Sections 406, 420 IPC, (Section 120-B of the IPC added later on) at Police Station P.S. Gharaunda, District Karnal.

The learned counsel for the petitioners submit that in compliance of the order dated 21.02.2022, petitioner have joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer. Even otherwise, civil proceedings have been initiated by the complainant against the petitioners by way of filing of a civil suit for a specific performance (Annexure P-1).

A report dated 05.12.2022 has been filed on behalf of the respondent-State by the learned State counsel by way of an affidavit of Manoj Kumar, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Gharaunda, Karnal and the same is taken on record. He on instructions from

SI Bhahadur Singh admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioners are no more required for custodial interrogation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 21.02.2022 is made absolute. However, the petitioners shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and they shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
