This is petitioner's fourth attempt to get bail pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR no. 21 dated 14.04.2019 registered under Section 21 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 and Section 379/411 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Arif Ke, District Ferozepur.

The first petition for grant of bail was dismissed on 17.10.2019 after noticing that the alleged recovery from the petitioner is 270 grams of Heroin (contraband) which falls in the commercial category and he is also involved in an another case under the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

The second petition for grant of bail was dismissed on 28.01.2021 and the third one was dismissed on 30.06.2021.

Pursuant to the directions of the Court, status report has been filed by way of the affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division, Ferozepur wherein it has been disclosed that the petitioner is involved in the following cases:-

“1. FIR No. 237 dated 15.11.2018 under section 307,34, 506 IPC, PS City Ferozpur. (under investigation).

2. FIR No. 122 dated 15.11.2017 u/s 382, 201 IPC, 25, 27, 54, 59 of Arms Act, PS Kulgari. (Final report has been prepared, which is under checking before DA (Legal) office.

3. FIR No. 55 dated 02.05.2017 u/s 302,307,506,336, 148,149 IPC& Section 25,27,54,59 Arms Act, PS Kulgari. (In this case petitioner was declare innocent).

4. FIR No. 74 dated 27.03.2021 under section 52-A Prison Act, PS City Ferozpur.

5. FIR No. 162 dated 28.07.2018 u/s 22/61/85 of the NDPS Act & Section 52-A Prison Act, PS City Ferozpur. (Under trial).”

The trial of the case is also at its fag end as out of 18 prosecution witnesses proposed to be examined, 12 witnesses have already been examined.

Hence, no ground to grant concession of bail to the petitioner is made out.

Dismissed.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
