Present petition has been filed for the grant of interim bail to the petitioner so as to attend the marriage ceremony of his brother-in-law, which is scheduled to be performed from 27.02.2022 to 01.03.2022.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in case, the prayer of the petitioner is accepted, the petitioner will maintain good conduct and will surrender before the jail authorities immediately on the expiry of the interim bail.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State, on the instructions from ASI Tarsem Singh, submits that the marriage of the brother-in-law of the petitioner is scheduled to be performed from 27.02.2022 to 01.03.2022.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the record with their able assistance.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has undertaken before this Court to maintain good conduct in case he is extended the concession of interim bail to attend the marriage of his brother-in-law scheduled to be performed from 27.02.2022 to 01.03.2022, the prayer of the petitioner for grant of interim bail is accepted.

Petitioner is directed to be released on interim bail from 27.02.2022 till 03.03.2022 subject to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate. Petitioner is also directed to surrender back on 03.03.2022 by 05:00 P.M.

The present petition is disposed of in above terms.
