The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Petitioner Mangat Singh has come up in this invocation by way of instant civil writ petition in terms of Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of appropriate writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing orders dated 16.12.2021 (Annexure P6) by virtue of which respondent No.1 has refused to exercise his powers over respondent No.2, and has challenged orders dated 12.08.2021 (Annexure P4) passed by respondent No.1 refusing to pass speaking order and thereby seeking quashing of orders dated 27.09.2021 (Annexure P5) whereby a decision has been made by passing a non-speaking order contrary to the principles of law.
