1. At the outset, learned counsel contends that the petitioner has submitted a number of representations, lastly vide Annexure P-12 dated 21.01.2022 but no decision has been taken on the same till date and that in the circumstances, the petitioner would be satisfied if the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide representation Annexure P-12 dated 21.01.2022 in a time bound manner.

2. Notice of motion to respondent No.2 only.

3. Mr. Pawan Kumar Longia, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice and after perusal of the writ petition states that he has no objection to the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

4. Accordingly, in view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the parties but without commenting upon the merits of the case, the instant petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide representation, Annexure P-12 dated 21.01.2022 by passing a speaking order in accordance with law after taking into account all aspects of the matter within four weeks from today.
