N.S.SHEKHAWAT, J. (Oral)

Learned counsel for the petitioners has confined his prayer only to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and submits that respondents No. 6 to 11 are harassing, beating and threatening to kill the petitioners and they apprehend danger even to their lives. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that they have already submitted a representation dated 21.01.2021 (Annexure P-2) to respondent No. 4, the Senior Superintendent of Police, U.T., Chandigarh and prays that he may be directed to consider the said representation as per law with a view to protect their lives and liberty.

In view of the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioners, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 4 to pass appropriate orders on the representation Annexure P-2 as per law, as expeditiously as possible.

However, the petitioners are at liberty to move an appropriate petition before the appropriate Court of law for the redressal of their other grievances, in accordance with law.

The present petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
