By this order, four Regular First Appeals i.e RFA-710-2022,

711-2022, 712-2022 and 713-2022 shall stand disposed of.

The appellants pray for condonation of delay of 10,281 days in filing the appeal, which roughly in terms of years comes to 28 years. The appellant prays for condonation of colossal delay on the ground that they had handed over the documents for filing Regular First Appeal to a common person but he did not file the appeal on their behalf. It is evident that a batch of Regular First Appeals was decided by the High Court on 02.11.2018. The appellants claim that when the other villagers approached the authorities then they came to know of the fact that no appeal on their behalf has been filed.

The present appeal has been filed on 17.02.2022. Even as per the assertions made in the applications, the appellants came to know of the fact that no appeal on their behalf has been filed in the High Court in the month of November, 2018. The name of person to whom the documents for filing of the appeal were entrusted, has also not been disclosed. In the considered view of this Bench, the appellants have failed to furnish sufficient reasons for seeking condonation of delay of 10,281 days.

Hence, the applications for condonation of delay are dismissed in all the four cases and consequently, the main appeals also stand dismissed.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
