Vide this petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of a direction to the official respondents to register a criminal case against respondents no. 4 to 6 for allegedly committing a fraud to the tune of Rs. 5 lakhs on the pretext of providing job to his son Gagan Singh in MES as well as for providing forged and fabricated ID- cards.

A reply dated 07.07.2022 has been filed by the learned State counsel today in Court, which is taken on record, with a copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner points to paragraph no.4 to 6 of the reply, vide which FIR has been registered against respondents no.2 to 5 and submits that therefore, this petition has been rendered infructuous.

In view of the above, this petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
