This case has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Instant petition raises a prayer for grant of emergency parole to the petitioner for a period of two weeks on the ground that marriage of petitioner's nephew and niece is to take place between the period from 05.03.2022 to 07.03.2022.

Instant petition had come up for preliminary hearing before this Court on 03.03.2022 and while issuing notice for today, learned State counsel had been requested to complete instructions.

Mr. Deepak Bhardwaj, learned Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, has forwarded a status report from the Superintendent of Prison, Central Prison-1, Hisar, along with Annexure R/T-1.

The same is taken on record and a copy thereof has been supplied to counsel opposite.

Perusal of Annexure R/T-1 is a report from Station House Officer, Police Station Agroha and which recites that upon verification having been done, it has been found that the petitioner is not the uncle and rather marriage to be solemnized on 06/07.03.2022 is that of uncle's son namely Manoj and two daughters namely Manju and Sita.

There would be no occasion for this Court to disbelieve such exercise of verification. The instant petition, as such, is founded on wrong assertion as regards the petitioner being the uncle/Mama and to perform the *Bhaat* ceremony. That apart, Annexure R/T-1 also discloses that the petitioner is a habitual offender and is involved in five other FIRs.

In view of above, prayer made in the instant petition is declined.

Petition is dismissed.
