Prayer in the instant writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondents to initiate action against the private respondents who are alleged to be illegally interfering into the affairs of Dharamshala/Gurudwara.

Written statement on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 had been filed by way of affidavit of Harinder Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Adampur, District Jalandhar wherein it has been specified that the matter was enquired into by the SHO, Police Station Bhogpur and the allegations levelled therein were found to be false. Even thereafter, the application dated 05.10.2019 submitted by the petitioners to

the Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar (Rural) was marked to the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Special Branch, Jalandhar (Rural) for inquiry. Yet another application dated 26.12.2019 was also submitted by the petitioners to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar (Rural), which was enquired into and the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Special Branch, Jalandhar (Rural) conducted the inquiry into the same. The allegations were found to be false. Furthermore, as a preventive action, proceedings under Sections 107, 150 Cr.P.C. were initiated and *kalandra* was also prepared and submitted in the court of Sub Divisional Magistrate, Jalandhar-2. The Senior Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Adampur found that no further action is required to be taken in the matter and the application/complaint submitted by the petitioners was recommended to be filed.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners seeks permission to withdraw the present civil writ petition with liberty to initiate appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty, as aforesaid.
