The petitioner assails the correctness of the order passed by the Secretary to Government of Punjab, Department of Rural Development and Panchayats, Punjab, on 16.12.2021, while accepting the appeal filed by respondent no.5, challenging her suspension.

The Secretary, while accepting the appeal, has set aside the order of suspension and ordered reinstatement of respondent no.5 to the office of Sarpanch of the Gram Panchayat, Dehriwal (Shekhupur Kalan, Block Bhunga, District Hoshiarpur.

The petitioner is one of the complainants in a pending complaint against the Sarpanch.

The learned counsel representing the petitioner contends that the Secretary has passed the impugned order without considering the various other aspects and the allegations against respondent no.5.

In the considered view of the Court, while exercising the writ jurisdiction, the Court is expected to examine the correctness of the impugned order passed. If a particular aspect has not been considered by the Secretary, the petitioner has a remedy of filing an application before the

Secretary, Department of Rural Development and Panchayats, Punjab,
drawing his attention to any such matter.

With these observations, the writ petition is disposed of.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also
disposed of.
