[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 14.11.2019, in CWP No.32896 of 2019 in case titled as '**Rajender Singh**versus**State of Haryana and others**'.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1), reveals that CWP No.32896 of 2019, was disposed of by directing the respondent to consider and decide the representation filed by the petitioner in accordance with law within six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the judgment and in case, on consideration, the competent authority came to the conclusion that the request made by the petitioner was admissible, consequential relief was to be allowed to the petitioner within six weeks thereafter but in case the competent authority came to the conclusion that the relief claimed by the petitioner was not admissible, in that case, a speaking order was required to be passed in the matter.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that needful has been done in terms of order (Annexure P-1) dated 14.11.2019 and speaking order (Annexure R-3) dated 22.01.2020 has been passed by the respondent, deciding the claim of the petitioner and the petitioner is satisfied with the same and that in the circumstances, the petitioner does not wish to pursue the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
