Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioners seek anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 10 dated 24.01.2021, registered under Sections 452, 323, 426, 148 and 149 IPC, at Police Station Adampur, District Jalandhar.

Vide order dated 22.02.2021 passed by a Coordinate Bench, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 22.02.2021, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kewal Singh, submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are not required for any further investigation.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 22.02.2021 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioners is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
