The petitioners are students of two years Diploma Course in Elementary Education. They have passed the first year examination and their only grievance is that the second year examination is not being held. It has been delayed by more than seven months. Meanwhile, respondent No.2 has conducted the Punjab State Teacher Eligibility Test and thus, the inordinate delay is not justified. Even, representation dated 08.02.2022 (Annexure P-16) has not been responded to.

Considering the nature of the order being passed, no reply is necessary.
