Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.37 dated 19.1.2022 registered under Sections 21, 27-A of NDPS Act at Police Station City Rewari, District Rewari.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police in light of previous order dated 28.2.2022 passed by this Court. State Counsel on instructions from SI Pritam Singh has admitted this fact and further stated that the petitioner is not required by the police for any further investigation or custodial interrogation.

Present case is relating to recovery of alleged recovery of 65 grams of *ganja* (non-commercial) from one Vishnu who disclosed to the police that he purchased the same from one Satish who was later on arrested. Further there are allegations that the present petitioner was nominated as accused on the basis of the alleged disclosure made by

aforsaid Satish to the effect that he used to sell *ganja* to the present petitioner.

Recovery has already been effected in this case and the petitioner has joined the investigation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 28.2.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
