Petitioner has approached this Court praying for issuance of directions to expedite the trial of the case bearing No.CHI/64/2019 dated 10.05.2019 arising out of the FIR No.162 dated 12.09.2018, under Sections 406, 498-A, 323 of IPC (Section 201 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station City Sri Muktsar Sahib, District Sri Muktsar Sahib. He has also prayed for issuing direction to respondent to protect his life and liberty.

It has been submitted by the petitioner that a false and frivolous FIR was registered against him on 12th September, 2018. He further submits that petitioner has no malign against the complainant-wife and he wants to settle the dispute amicably with his wife. However, neither the trial is proceeding nor he is being allowed to have any meeting with his wife.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Sakshi Bakshi, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

In the attending facts and circumstances, petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial Court to expedite the trial and conclude the same at the earliest. Learned trial Court is further directed to appreciate the submission made by the petitioner and take requisite steps for settlement in case the parties are ready to settle the dispute amicably.
