The petitioner has invoked the writ jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking appropriate writ in the nature of mandamus for issuance of directions to the respondents for stepping up of pension as well as basic pay of the petitioner and in alternative to decide the legal notice dated 22.11.2021 (Annexure P-3).

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with direction to the official respondents to consider the legal notice dated 22.11.2021 (Annexure P3), as representation and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a

period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
