[1] Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

[2] Prayer in the petition under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India is for initiating action against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of orders, Annexure P/1 dated 20.08.2021 in CWP No.1943 of 2021 in case titled as Bhim Singh vs. State of Haryana and Ors.

[3] A perusal of orders, Annexure P/1 dated 20.08.2021 reveals that CWP No.1943 of 2021 was disposed of by directing respondent No.2 herein to decide representation dated 26.06.2020 and any other supplementary representation that may be moved by the petitioner by passing a speaking order within eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[4] Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the instant petition was filed on account of failure of respondent No.2 to do the needful.

[5] At the outset, learned DAG states that the instant petition is misconceived since representation dated 26.06.2020 was decided vide order dated 26.10.2021 by respondent No.2. Order dated 26.10.2021 is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who states that in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the contempt petition and the same may be disposed of as such while granting liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 26.10.2021 rejecting the representation dated 26.06.2020.

[6] In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against respondent No.2 under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 26.10.2021 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.
