1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/2, dated 04.04.2012, in CWP-6496-2012.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/2 dated 04.04.2012, reveals that CWP-6496-2012, was disposed of by directing the respondents to consider and decide legal notice dated 28.01.2011, within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case the petitioner was found entitled to the claim made by him in the legal notice, consequential benefits, if any be released to him, in accordance with law, within further period of two months.

3. Learned counsel states that pursuant to order dated 12.02.2020, calling for compliance report, speaking order dated 20.10.2020, has been passed by the respondent rejecting the claim of the petitioner as contained in legal notice dated 28.01.2011 and that in the circumstances the petitioner may be permitted to withdraw the instant

petition with liberty to challenge speaking order Annexure R/1 dated 20.10.2020, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent(s) under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
