The petitioner is the respondent's wife. Through this revision petition, filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, she prays for direction to the Family Court to expeditiously take up and adjudicate the application filed under Section 24 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, in HMA Case No.257 of 2021.

After a long spell of restricted functioning due to surge in the cases of Covid-19, the Courts have resumed functioning normally. Even though, an application under Section 24 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, for grant of monthly maintenance pendente lite is required to be decided expeditiously, however, this bench does not find it appropriate to issue any directions in view of the Covid-19 situation in the past.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the revision petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file an appropriate application before the Family Court, which shall be considered sympathetically.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
