Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that similar petitions i.e. CWP No. 24407 of 2018 titled as ***Malkiat Singh Vs. Punjab State Power Corporation Limited and others*** and other connected cases, have been disposed of by this Court, vide order dated 19.12.2018, keeping in view the order passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CWP No. 1013 of 2017 titled as '**Balvir Singh Vs.
