[1] Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating action against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 27.10.2021 in CWP No.16669 of 2021 in case titled as 'ASI Ram Singh versus State of Punjab and others'.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P-1 reveals that CWP No. 16669 of 2021 was disposed of by directing the respondents to decide the statutory appeal filed by the petitioner within 04 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and till such time that decision was not taken on the appeal, recovery imposed would remain stayed.

[3] Learned Asstt. AG, Punjab refers to order (Annexure R-1) dated 04.04.2022, deciding the appeal in favour of the petitioner and setting aside the recovery imposed.

[4] Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in the circumstances, the petitioner does not press the instant petition.

learned counsel for the petitioner, the contempt petition is *disposed of*, as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
