Petitioner is seeking regular bail in case of FIR No.108 dated 26.9.2019, under Sections 15, 29 of NDPS Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Sujanpur, District Pathankot.

One of the ground for seeking bail is the custody period and the fact that the trial is not proceeding at decent pace.

Learned State counsel on instructions submits that there are total fourteen prosecution witnesses, six have been examined and remaining eight are the official witnesses and they would be examined within three months from today.

In view of statement made, the petition for regular bail is disposed of at this stage with liberty to petitioner to revive the prayer in case of unnecessary delay in conclusion of the prosecution evidence, occurs.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending application, if any is rendered infructuous.
