The petitioner is boy aged just 15 years and keeping in view the nature of allegations and other facts and circumstances peculiar to this case, this petition is allowed and the petitioner shall be released on bail. In case, the Investigator wants that bail bonds are required then he may take personal bond to the sum of Rs.5000/- alongwith an undertaking to appear before the Juvenile Justice Board.
