Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that impugned FIR is worth to be quashed not only on the basis of compromise, but also on the basis of other factual merits of the case, as per which alleged offence is not made out. Counsel submits that for the said purpose, a comprehensive petition with all the grounds taken therein, would be required to be filed again. Therefore, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to file a fresh petition with all the details therein i.e. factual merits as well as the factum of compromise.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforementioned liberty.
