Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.180 dated 26.8.2021 registered under Sections 323, 324, 34 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on) at Police Station Civil Line Batala, District Gurdaspur.

On the last date of hearing, after hearing contentions raised by both the parties, this Court passed order of interim bail dated 25.2.2022 in favour of the petitioner. Today, counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation in compliance of order dated 25.2.2022 passed by this Court.

State counsel on instructions from ASI Davinder Singh has admitted the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and she further stated that weapon used by the petitioner at the time of occurrence, has been recovered by the police at his instance and the petitioner is not

required by the police for any further investigation or custodial

interrogation.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 25.2.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
