The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.237 dated 6.12.2021 registered under Sections 363, 366-A and 120-B IPC (Section 120-B IPC was added vide GD No.22 dated 19.12.2021), at Police Station Baghapurana, District Moga.

By virtue of the order dated 25.2.2022, while granting interim protection, the petitioners were directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners have joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kanwaljit Singh, has endorsed the fact that the petitioners have joined the investigation and no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the order dated 25.2.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
