The petitioner has invoked the writ jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking appropriate writ in the nature of mandamus for issuance of directions to the respondents to decide the legal notice/representation dated 05.08.2021 (Annexure P6) to release the arrears of regular service as per order (Annexure P3) passed by the Presiding Officer, Labour Court Patiala as well as to release the pensionary benefits of the petitioner after his superannuation along with all consequential benefits.

Record perused as none has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner.

Notice of motion to the official respondents.

Ms. Anju Sharma Kaushik, Dy. Advocate General, Punjab puts in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the said respondents. Copy of the paper book has been supplied to her.

Upon perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with direction to the official respondents to consider the legal notice dated 05.08.2021 (Annexure P6), as representation and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
