The petitioners have invoked the writ jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking appropriate writ in the nature of mandamus for issuance of directions to the respondents to release all pensionary benefits to the petitioners including fixation of pension in the light of judgment (Annexure P6), seeking a further writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing of orders (Annexure P2) and clarification (Annexure P5), and in alternative to decide the legal notice dated 26.02.2021 (Annexure P-7).

Heard.

Notice of motion to the official respondents.

Ms. Anju Sharma Kaushik, Dy. Advocate General, Punjab puts in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the said respondents.

Copy of the paper book has been supplied to her.

Upon hearing learned counsel for both the sides and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with direction to the official respondents to consider the legal notice dated 26.02.2021 (Annexure P7), as representation and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioners without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
