The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.123 dated 10.11.2021, registered under Sections 336, 427, 506, 148, 149 of the IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Mohkampura, District Police Commissionerate, Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter stands compromised between the parties and a petition, bearing CRM-M-7978-2022 has already been filed by the petitioner and others seeking quashing of the FIR on the basis of the compromise, wherein vide order of the even date, the parties have been directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaqia Magistrate for recording of their statement in support of the compromise. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that only Section 25 of the Arms Act is non bailable.

Learned counsel further submits that though the petitioner is involved in some other cases, however, in majority of the cases, he is on bail.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Joginder Pal Ratra, DAG, Punjab and Mr. G. S. Thind, Advocate, who are present in Court, accept notice on behalf of the respondent-State and respondent No.2/complainant, respectively, Learned counsel for respondent No. 2/complainant does not dispute the factual position and admits to the factum of compromise entered into between the parties.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is granted the concession of anticipatory bail, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

However, it will be open for the Investigating Officer to call upon the petitioner to join investigation, if so required, by issuing him a written notice in this regard.
