Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.27 dated 1.2.2022 registered under Sections 420, 120-B IPC at Police Station Bhawanigarh, District Sangrur.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in light of order dated 23.2.2022.

State counsel on instructions from SI Kashmir Singh admitted the aforesaid fact and further stated that the petitioner is not required by the police for any further investigation.

As per allegations in the FIR, complainant-Sukhwinder Singh and Jagvinder Singh used to sell their agricultural produce to the petitioner who is running the business of Commission Agent; that the petitioner took particulars of the bank account of the complainant on the pretext of

account. Later on, the complainant came to know that the petitioner took loan by misusing his aforesaid bank account.

Admittedly, the entire case is based on documentary evidence. Now nothing remains to be recovered from the petitioner who has already joined the investigation.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 23.2.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
