1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 29.03.2019, in CWP-8581-2019.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1, dated 29.03.2019, reveals that CWP-8581-2019, was disposed of by directing the respondents to consider and decide the claim made in legal notice dated 24.01.2019, within three months, from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the needful having been done and claim of the petitioners as raised in legal notice dated 24.01.2019, having been accepted and benefits claimed thereunder, released to the petitioners, the petitioners are not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

4. In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
