The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.91 dated 11.06.2019 registered under Sections 379-B, 341, 427, 147 and 148 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and under Section 8-B of the National Highway Act, 1956 at Police Station Dhanaula, District Barnala.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that the matter has already been compromised between the parties vide compromise deed dated 26.02.2021 (Annexure P-3) and the petitioners have also joined the investigation

Learned State counsel submits that in pursuance of order dated 05.04.2022 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation and are no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above facts, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated

05.04.2022 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioners is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
