Case has been heard through video conferencing on account of Covid-19 Pandemic.

Present petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking quashing of entire proceedings undertaken by respondent No.2-Punjab State Commission for NRIs on the complaint moved by respondent No.7-Darshan Singh Malhi as is reflected from order dated 29.10.2020 (Annexure P-11) passed by respondent No.2 in connection with FIR No.118 dated 27.4.2006 registered under Sections 420, 409, 467, 120-B IPC at Police Station Division No.5, District Ludhiana, on the ground that the aforesaid complaint was lodged by respondent No.7 being attorney of Pritam Kaur, who had already died on 15.6.2014.

Counsel for the petitioner submitted that in this regard, he lodged complaints dated 31.12.2020 (Annexure P-6) and 11.1.2021 (Annexure P-7) with respondent No.2 but till date, no action has been taken by the said Commission. He further submitted that he will be satisfied if

necessary direction is given to the Commission to consider and decide aforesaid complaints Annexures P-6 and P-7 in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. C.L.Pawar, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State. He submitted that in case any such complaints are pending with respondent No.2, the Commission could be directed to dispose off the same in accordance with law.

In view of above, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is hereby disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide complaints Annexures P-6 and P-7 in accordance with law, within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
