Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.266 dated 26.11.2021 for offence punishable under Section 506 IPC registered at Police Station Sector 27, District Sonapat.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 24.02.2022 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel on instructions from HC Satpal submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 24.02.2022 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 24.02.2022 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
