The petitioner has invoked jurisdiction by preferring the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to make necessary correction in the passport, by including the name of adopted parents and name of the spouse and thereafter, re-issue passport to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the passport bearing No.W6430582 has been issued to the petitioner on 14.11.2022, valid upto 13.11.2032. Learned counsel would further submit that in view of the same, cause of action in the present petition does not survive and the same be disposed of as such.

Learned counsel for the respondents affirms the aforesaid position and submits that the passport was dispatched at the given address through speed post against tracking No.PP839148185IN on 15.11.2022. He further submits that there is no objection to the petition being disposed of accordingly.

Disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
