The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking directions to respondent No.3 to grant parole to the petitioner for 4 weeks. The ground for release is for eye surgery of the wife. The claim is made under Section 3(1)(a) of Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 2007.

As per the pleadings, it is stated that the petitioner was convicted on 09.01.2019 and he had been granted temporary release on 21.11.2019 (Annexure P-2) for 3 days for attending wedding of the daughter of the sister and he had surrendered thereafter.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Palika Monga, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and points out that representation dated 15.02.2022 (Annexure P-3) is already pending before respondent No.3 and in such circumstances, assures the Court that respondent No.3/competent authority shall decide the request for grant of parole.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with directions to respondent No.3/competent authority to decide the request for parole. In case representation dated 15.02.2022 (Annexure P-3) has not been received as such, respondent No.3/competent Authority shall treat the writ petition as a representation and take a call upon it within a period of 2 weeks from today.
