The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 167 dated 25.07.2020, under Sections 323, 324, 341, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 ('IPC' - for short) (Sections 325 and 326 of the IPC were added later on), registered at Police Station Samana, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been attributed only simple injuries. The petitioner is an ex-serviceman.

Heard.

The petitioner was allegedly armed with a 'kirpan' and has caused two injuries on the head and chest of the complainant. The injury on the head has been described as under:

“Incised wound of 3.8 cm x 0.6 cm x 1 cm present over right side of head with fresh bleed approximately 3.5 cm away from injury No. 1. Advice X-ray skull.”

The petitioner and other co-accused have caused as many as nine injuries on the complainant. This is the second petition for anticipatory bail. The earlier petition had been dismissed as withdrawn on 23.12.2021. I do not find any change in circumstances to take another view in the matter at this stage.

In view of the above, this petition stands dismissed.

However, it is clarified that nothing which has been observed here-in-above shall be deemed to have any bearing on the merits of the case.
